SUMMARY

Subject stated that the chief of staff of the Ninth Army was General STADCKE. His adjutant was Lt. Colonel SCHINDLER and quartermaster Colonel RODENSTEIN. Source thinks that Corps Group Bach (Korps-Gruppe Bach) was subordinate to the Ninth Army, as far as supplies were concerned, hence the Chief Quartermaster (Oberquartiermeister) was responsible for the entire operational territory.
