1971 at her home, Wilsbaden, Sauerbrunn.

1. Do Stabe of Bundesarchiv-Militärarchiv visited her
ca. 1966 and after inspecting the papers took
them relating to war years.

2. Upstatts, "auf dem Boden", she has and on two
boxes of Salzmuth's papers including "private
Tagebücher" (whether only those of Kriegsjahren-
schaft - written on toilet paper - or also of later years
in America; she has not read them herself) and
she answered my unasked question by saying
she would not allow anybody access to them (she
truly not Do Stabe). My impression: She will later
verify this visit if patiently followed up.

3. She son, Herr Hans-Dietrich v. S., 5 Köln-Brück,
Lelienthalweg 31 (Tel. (0221) 843805) leaves for
service from 1924.

4. I should contact her again after she has had time
to inspect the boxes: "Das verspreche ich Ihnen."

5. She strongly recommended I contact Frau v.
Siedding in Kiel: great power of memory.
[Frequently in Düsseldorf, according to Frau Bäcker.]
