

Notes stemming from an interview of Frau Elly von Rosenberg and her son, 15. Mai 1971, Wittenberg, Thüringen.

1. Bernd v. Rosenberg wrote "Im Wachstumsführungsrat", publ. ca. 1955 by Verlag Völke, Hamburg; it was greatly distorted (politically) by them; they may have the original MS. He also wrote a 78 pp. "Bavaria-geschichte", which I borrowed.
2. v. Rosenberg could not slide Washington, who was half as big as he; over there, had a standing authority until and almost came to power. But he always admitted W. was "fähig", - "ein sehr tüchtiger Mann".
3. I recommended me to read Besymenster: "Lindbergh's Abenteuer". The Rosenberg story, it quotes also Lindbergh's flying adventure is quite genuine. Date uncertain. Hitler will not have been long much absent during the period he was. He thinks little of Lindbergh's book; Bernd von Rosenberg was in Gefangenschaft (UK) with Lindbergh.
4. Frau v. Rosenberg recalls parents as v. h. reformed, baptised, fundamentalist, mother was within in Teufelsdröckel-münchener Bewegung, anglophobe und ja v. Brauchetich; kann genau nachlesen: "Ja! Adolf Hitler hat Befehl gegeben, dass alle Juden...!" Tel.gramm, usw. (see book.)
5. Werkleids (Befürchtungen aus dem Gedächtnis, unediertes Buch) gehen 1965 nach Kassel, (Hr. M...)
